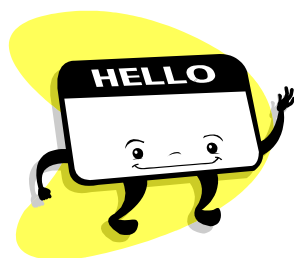
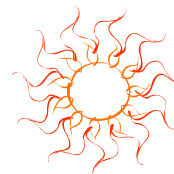
a volunteer basis. Thank you, ladies, for your years of service to the Society!

Thanks to a generous grant of \$29,600 from the **Wild Rose Foundation**, we were able to purchase new "cat castles" for the cat adoption rooms in the new facility. The addition of these new castles has substantially increased the number of cats we can care for in our adoption area. As importantly, the new castles allow the cats a larger, more comfortable living space and a private litter area. Thank you, Wild Rose Foundation, for helping to enrich the lives of the cats in our care and enabling us to rescue more of them!

Thank you to **The Calgary Foundation** for a grant which allowed the purchase of a pressure-washing system for the new facility. Shelter staff are grateful for this system which makes the cleaning part of their job much more efficient and therefore allows for more time to care for the animals.

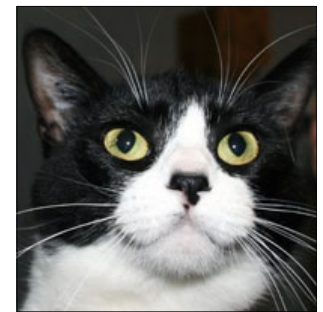
